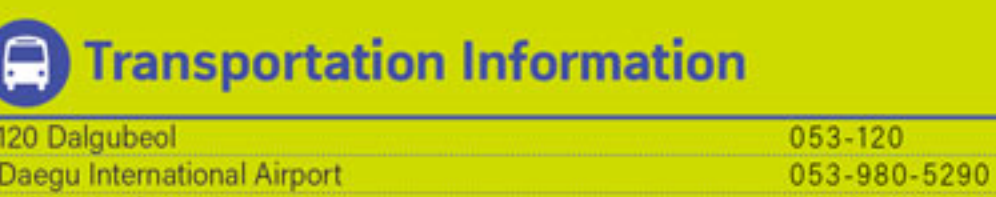

4A Yeongnamjeilgwan Gateway

248 Palhyeon-gil, Suseong-gu
Daegu Walled Town used to have four gates, of which Yeongnamjeilgwan Gateway is its south gate. Although the gateway was demolished together with the walled town in 1906, it was rebuilt at the current location in 1980, and has become Daegu's top destination for nighttime views.



2C Beomeocheon Stream

Jongang High School - Cheongju Negeri - Sincheon Market Negeri
Children's Hall Station - Suseongom Station
Beomeocheon Stream is an urban ecological stream and habitat for diverse aquatic plants and mallard ducks. The stream has become one of Daegu's famous destinations for its beautiful night views and its well-established walking trail, which follows the Daegu Metro Line 3 monorail and passes through a forest of high buildings.

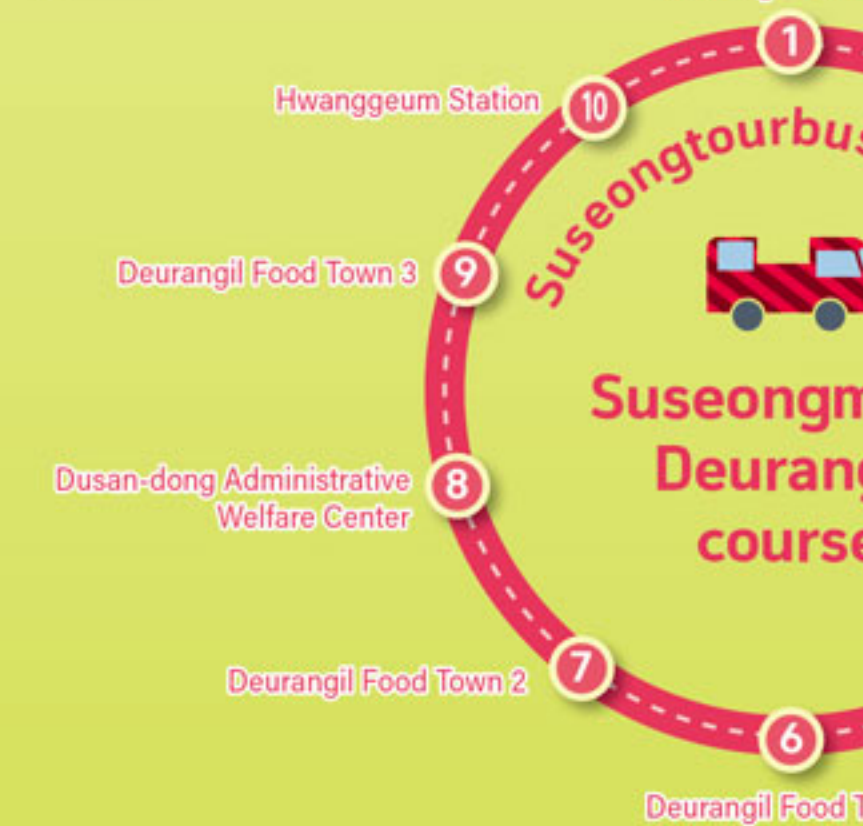


2C Suseongmot Lake

Dusan-dong, Suseong-gu
Suseongmot Lake was originally a reservoir created for agricultural irrigation, but has since transformed into a prominent landmark of Daegu, celebrated for its eco-friendly park. It has been recognized by the Korea Tourism Organization as one of the 100 Must-Visit Tourist Spots of Korea and the 100 Night Must-Visit Tourist Spots of Korea. The lake is adorned with a waterfront deck road, a show deck, and an ecological observation deck. In the evening, Dungsjeom Island and the deck road are beautifully illuminated by warm, cozy lights. Its highlight is the musical fountain day and night show, presented from end of March to October. Additionally, spontaneous busking performances and scheduled performances are held around Suseongmot Lake. Moreover, the annual "Suseong Lake Festival" and the "Light Art Festival Suseong" are hosted here every year.



▲ Suseong Tour Bus
As part of the smart tourism city creation project, Suseongmot Lake, Deurangil Food Town, Daegu Art Museum, and Daegu Kansong Art Museum are connected to each other to help tourists move easily. The bus operates at one-hour intervals and features an open roof, providing passengers with a refreshing feeling and a spacious experience.



Suseong Land
Suseong Land and Suseong Park Land offer a variety of exciting amusement facilities including a pirate ship ride, sky-biking, merry-go-rounds, and a roller coaster. It also has an ice rink and the unique Air Café, which is well-known among local citizens, and runs a craft experience program.



4B Momyeongjae Shrine

14-21 Dalgubeol-daero 525-gil, Suseong-gu
Momyeongjae Shrine was built to commemorate the life and achievements of Du Sa-chung by his descendants in 1912. Du Sa-chung was a general of the Ming Dynasty who came to help defend Joseon twice during the Japanese Invasions of Korea in 1592 and 1597. General Du later became a naturalized Korean.



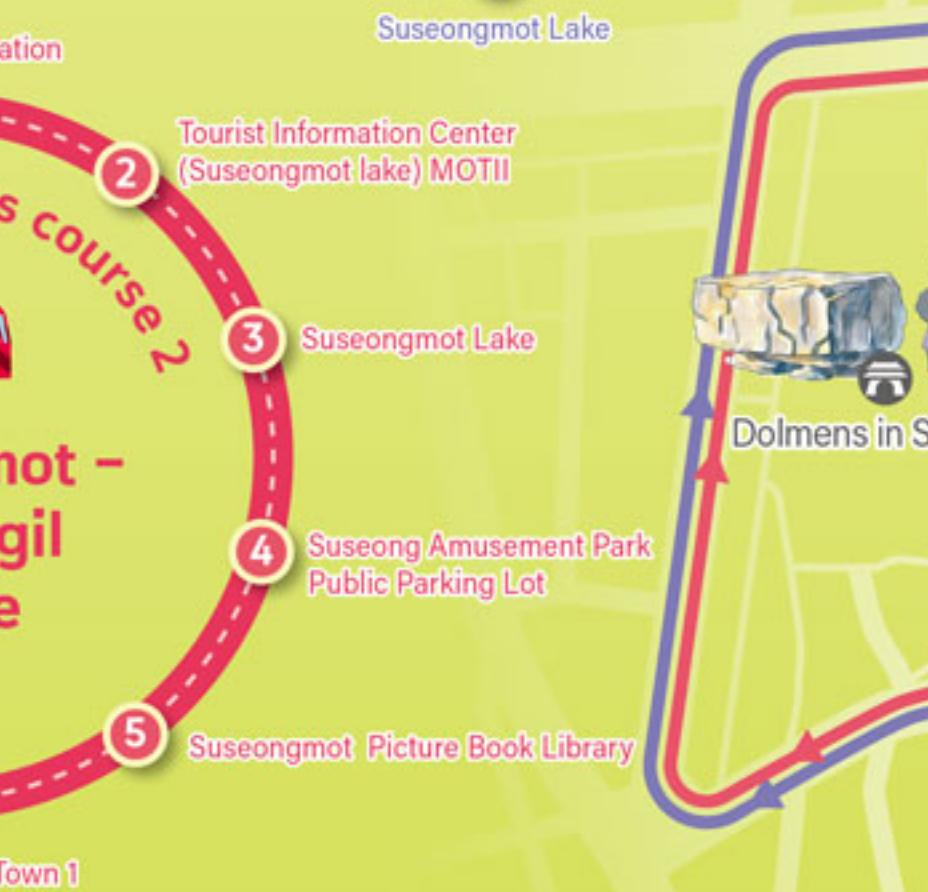
3B Beomeo Library

The Beomeo Library is a local cultural and educational hub composed of various facilities including a region-specialized International Reference Room, Brain Room (using teaching aid), Lifelong Learning Center, and Suseong Future Education Foundation.



2C Deurangil Food Town

Sang-dong - Dusan-dong in Suseong-gu
Deurangil Road, whose name originates from the fact that there used to be a road (gil) running through the middle (an) of Suseong Field (deu), is Daegu's famous food town. Visitors can enjoy delicious foods there and take a stroll along the nearby waterfront deck road of Suseongmot Lake, or enjoy a coffee in Café Street. The annual Deurangil Food Festival is held along and around this road.



Suseongmot Picture Book Library
It has more than 5,000 picture books by famous domestic and foreign artists that can be enjoyed by all ages, from children to adults. The low bookshelf is arranged wide, and it is a space where you can see the outside view through the window.



4B Korean Traditional Culture Center

There is a diverse array of programs designed to share the essence of Korean traditional culture with the world. These programs offer hands-on experiences and educational courses such as "Dance Harkok (traditional Korean clothes for the tea ceremony)", "Dongabugum (Principles and Practice of Eastern Medicine) Food", and "Tea Confectionery in Old Cookbooks". In addition, you can participate in the "Jukgung (bamboo bow archery) Experience" and "Traditional Liquor Experience" guided by a skilled traditional liquor artisan. These experiences and courses operate on a dedicated schedule, which you can confirm by phone.

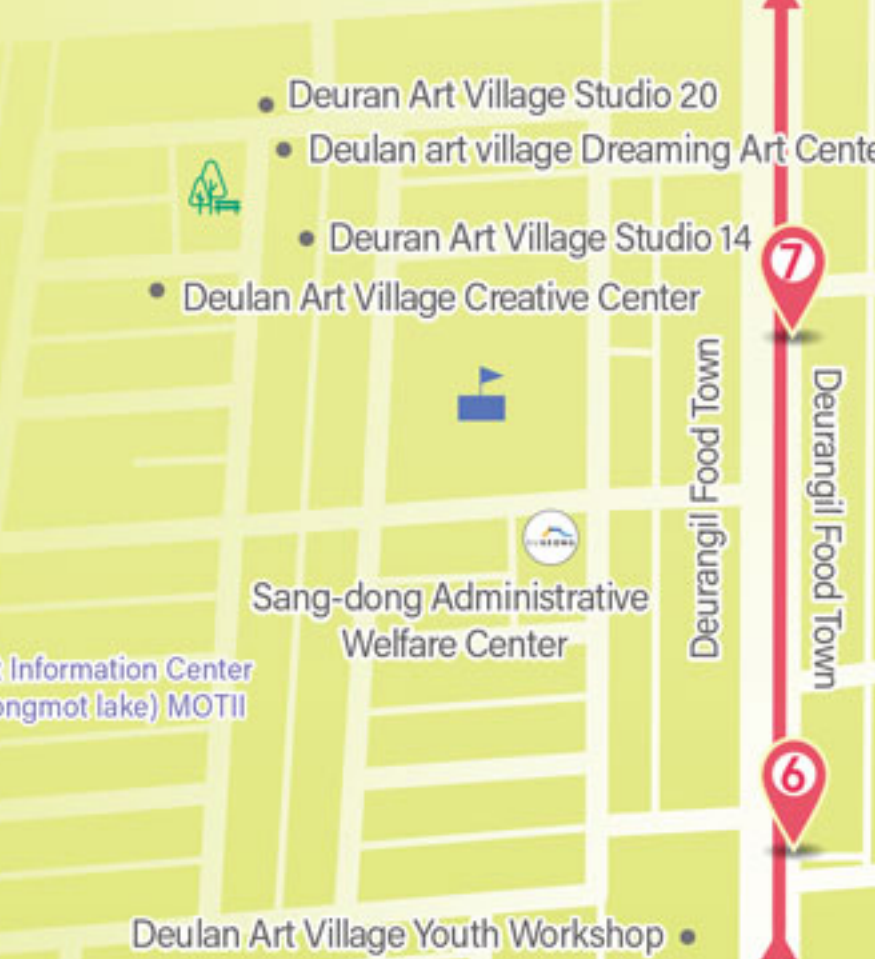


5C Daegu Stadium

180 Uniservia-ro, Suseong-gu
Daegu Stadium is designed to represent the Earth and to embrace the people of the world under one roof. It is known as the venue for some of the 2002 FIFA World Cup, the 2003 Summer Universiad, and the 2011 IAAF World Championships in Athletics.



▲ Deuran Art Village
Deuran Art Village, nestled in the alleyways of Deuran Street near Suseongmot Lake, is a cultural hub home to a variety of workshops, galleries, and other cultural spaces, as well as a gathering place for artists. You can participate in various experiential activities, from one-day classes to full courses.



3B Daegu National Museum

Daegu National Museum is a cultural complex designed to preserve, research, exhibit, and educate the cultural heritage of Daegu City and Gyeongsangbuk-do province. The museum features the clothing culture dating back to ancient and middle-age periods for the permanent exhibition, Children's museum, Thinking play room, Video experience room for kids.



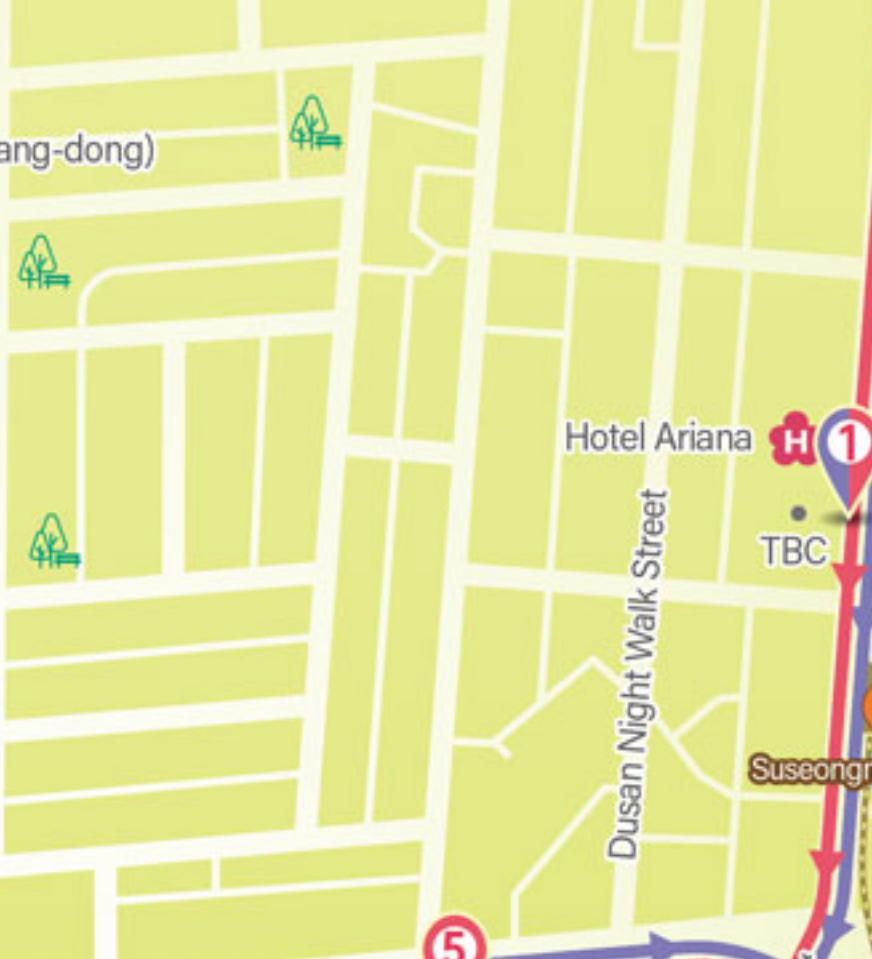
6D Uksugol Valley

Uksu-dong, Suseong-gu
Uksugol Valley, located near Uksusan Mountain, is known for its clear water flowing down over granite porphyry gravel. The valley is home to a dinosaur fossil site and Mangwoli Reservoir, which is the largest spawning ground for toads in Korea. Visitors can witness the amazing spectacle of millions of squimming baby toads in Uksugol Valley between late May and early June every year.



4D Jinbatgol Forest Park & Jinbatgol Campground

Jinbatgol Campground 053-666-3477
Jinbatgol is a deep valley that connects to the hiking trail leading to Yongjibong Peak. The valley is home to Jinbatgol Forest Park, Jinbatgol Campground, a forest park, and Jinbatgol Dullegi (Trail).



▲ Sanghwa Park and Poetry Street
Located just opposite the Deurangil Trail and Suseongmot Lake are Sanghwa Park and Poetry Street, where visitors can discover Poet Yi Sang-hwa's major works and his world of poetry.



5B Gomo multi culture zone

Gomo Station was a flag stop on the Gyeongbu Line, which was operated from 1925 to 2006. This historic site has now become a cultural complex where visitors can relax and experience Korea's traditional culture in the middle of the city center.



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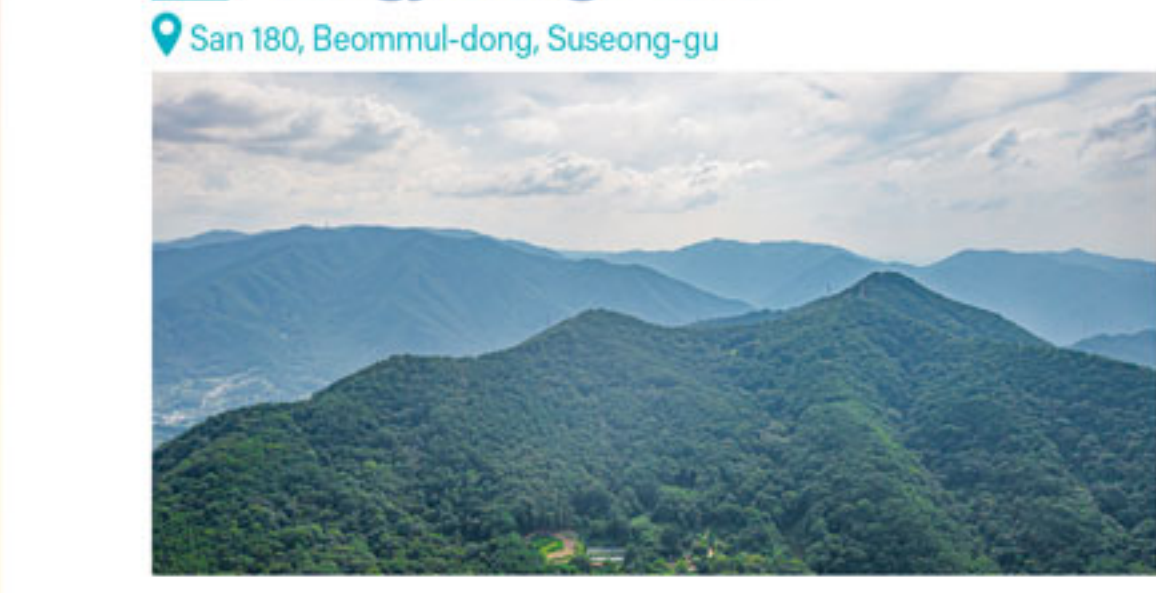

3E Yongjibong Peak

San 180, Beommul-dong, Suseong-gu
Yongjibong Peak takes its name from the fact that the top of the peak resembles the shape of a horn of a dragon. This low mountain (629 m) is easy to climb, and commands a wide open view of Suseong-gu.



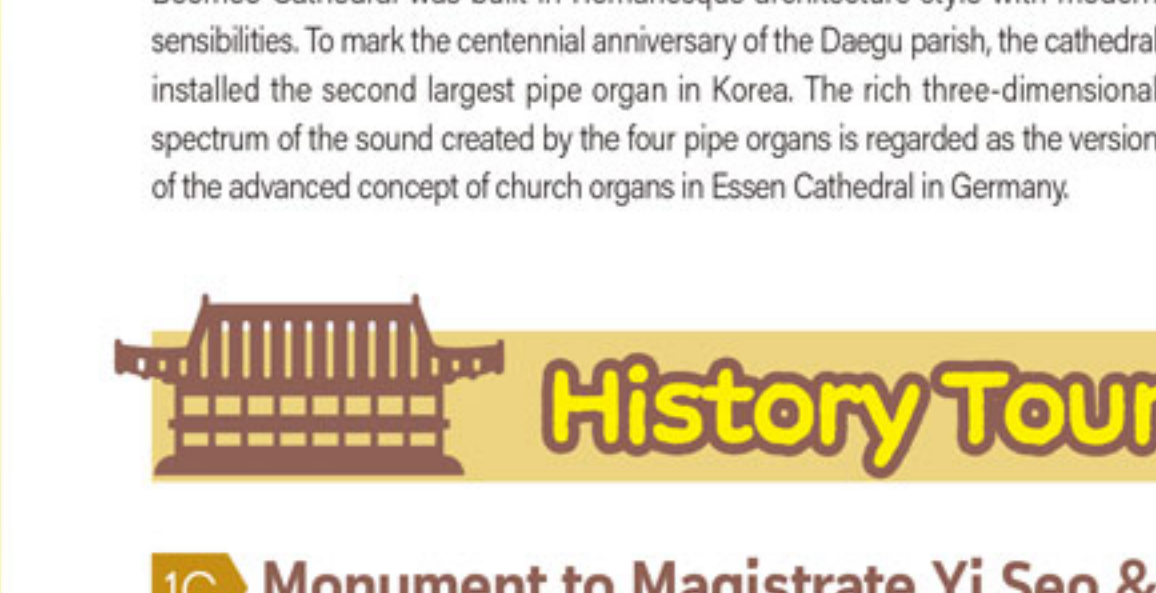
5A Geumhogang Migratory Bird Observatory

Gomo-dong, Suseong-gu
Palhyeon is a small village known for its famous bird sanctuary located near the Geumhogang River. The migratory bird observatory is situated near to Palhyeon Marsh.



2C Suseong Artpia

As an art center representing the area, Suseong Artpia operates programs in three categories: exhibition, performance, and art academy.



2B Beomeo Cathedral

90 Beomeocheon-ro, Suseong-gu
Beomeo Cathedral was built in Romanesque architecture style with modern sensibilities. To mark the centennial anniversary of the Daegu parish, the cathedral installed the second largest pipe organ in Korea. The rich three-dimensional spectrum of the sound created by the four pipe organs is regarded as the version of the advanced concept of church organs in Essen Cathedral in Germany.



3C Muhak Forest Library

73-10 Cheongju-ro 40-gil, Suseong-gu 053-668-1821
Sited inside Muhaksan Park in Jisan-dong, the eco-friendly library offers various experiential programs on ecology. Around Muhak Forest Library is a field of grass surrounded by a lush forest, and there is the Muhaksan Forest Therapy Center for children nearby.

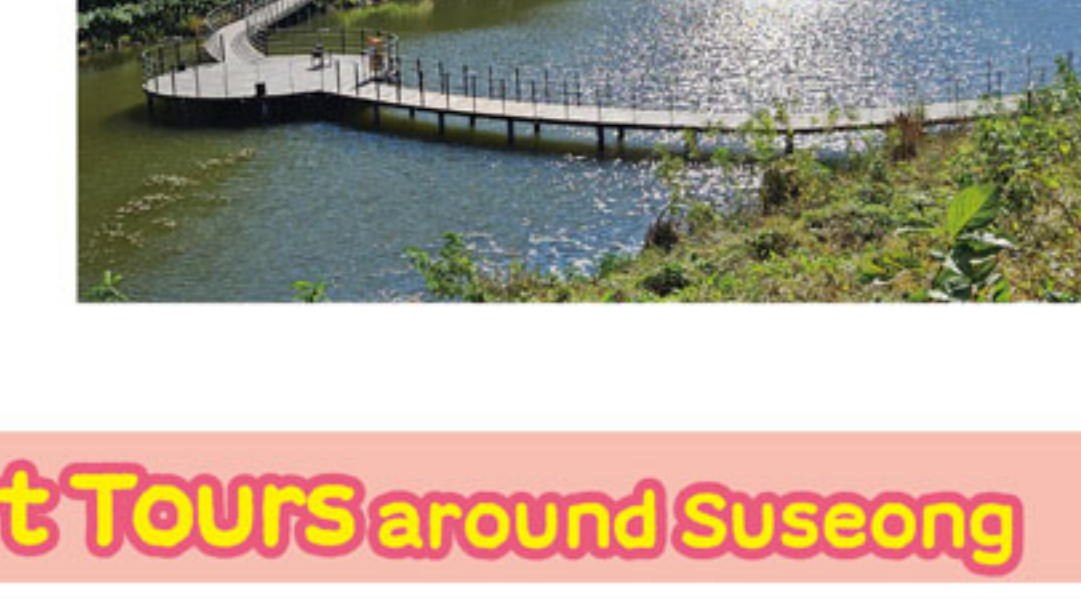


19 Sanghwa-ro 3-gil, Suseong-gu
Built around 1900, the building was used as a tomb keeper's house for the Jin Clan. The Yasujeong House features a combination of Korean and Japanese architectural styles.



4D Daedeokji Pond

Daedeokji pond is an urban ecological relaxation space equipped with a nature trail and a water deck that harmonize with the surrounding landscape.



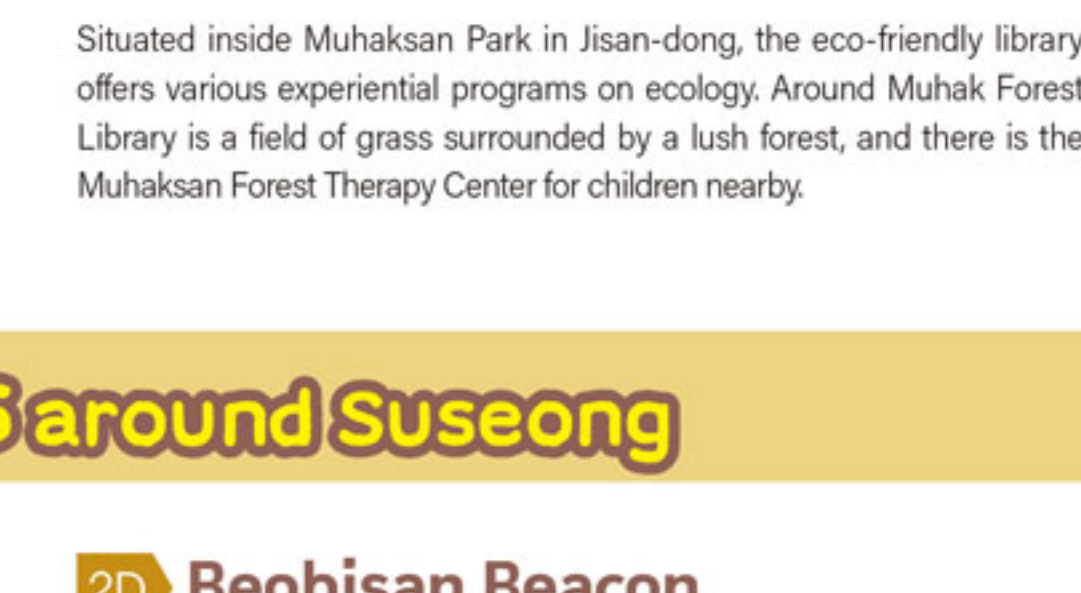
4C Yeonhonaegi Pond

422 Yeonho-dong, Suseong-gu
Located near Yeonho-dong, a quiet rural village, Yeonhonaegi Pond is known for its beautiful lotus flowers which bloom in harmony with the surrounding landscape in July and August.



2A Jeong Ho-seung Literature Museum & Poetry Monument to Jeong Ho-seung

403-1 Deuran-ro, Suseong-gu
The Jeong Ho-seung Literature Museum is situated near Beomeocheon Stream, where poet Jeong Ho-seung developed his dreams of becoming a poet during his childhood, which served as the cornerstone of his literary career. If you follow Beomeocheon Stream, which flows in front of the Literature Museum, you will encounter a monument bearing an inscription of Jeong Ho-seung's poem ("To Daffodils").



2D Beobisan Beacon

26-san, Dusan-dong, Suseong-gu
The beacon fire station, situated atop Beobisan Mountain's summit, served as a vital communication hub during the Joseon Dynasty. This location holds the distinction of being designated as Daegu City's inaugural beacon cultural heritage. Compared to other beacons found across the country, it boasts significant historical value with its well-preserved structure, shape, size, and intricate features, such as protective walls and entrances.



133 Uksueon-ro, Suseong-gu
The Dolmens in Sawol-dong consist of four dolmens dating back to the Bronze Age. They serve as the important cultural heritage indicating remnants of a prehistoric village in the Sawol area.



6B Cheoneulsan Mountain

Behind Gosan Elementary School in Siji-dong, Suseong-gu
Cheoneulsan Mountain is the site of an annual sunrise festival. Visitors can enjoy walking here while appreciating the beautiful scenery of the Geumhogang River.



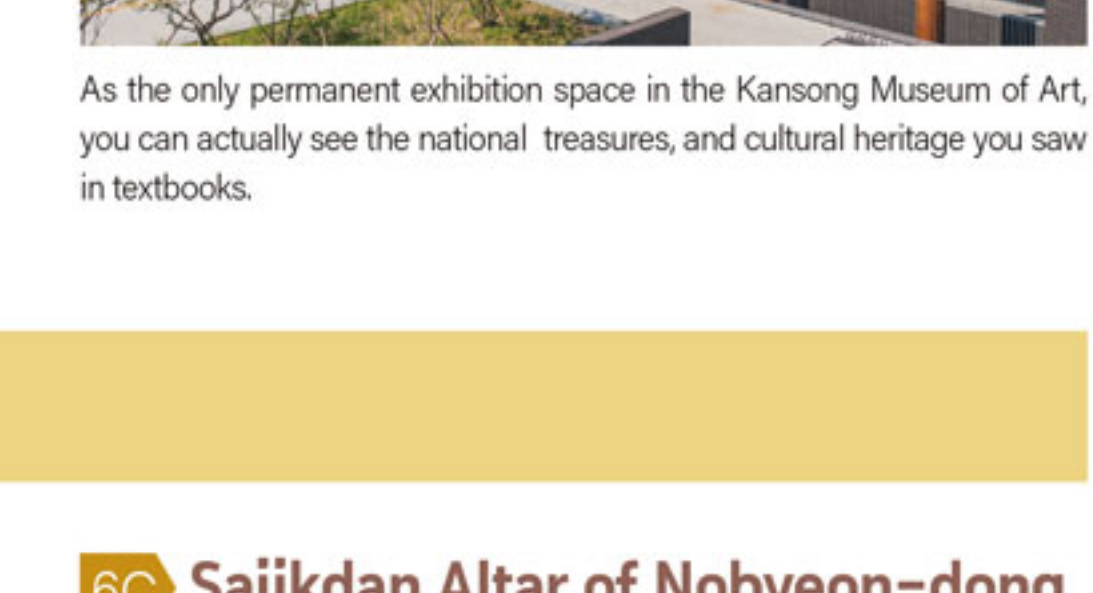
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5C Daegu Art Museum

The Daegu Art Museum is the largest municipal museum in the Yeongnam region. The museum offers exhibitions displaying artworks by Korean and overseas artists as well as various cultural programs including special lectures and symposiums.



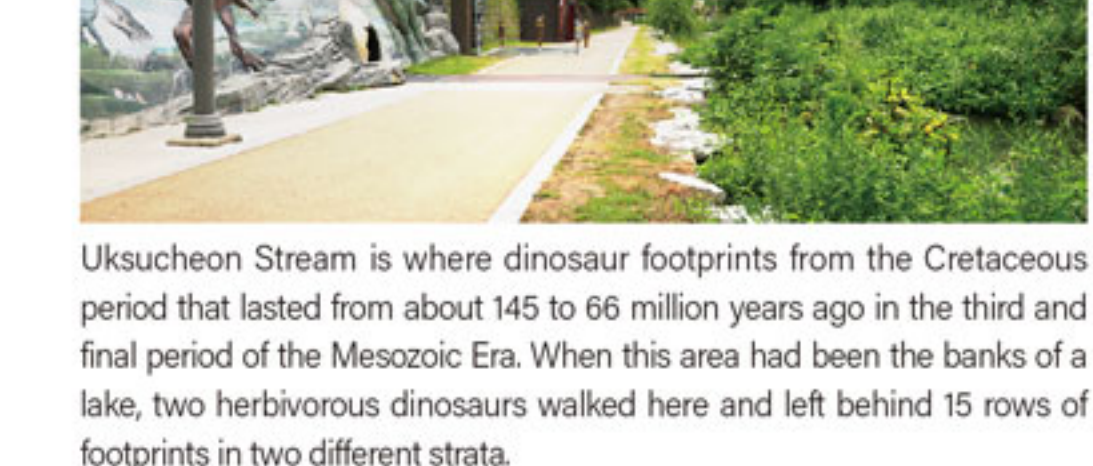
5C Daegu Kansong Art Gallery

As the only permanent exhibition space in the Kansong Museum of Art, you can actually see the national treasures, and cultural heritage you saw in textbooks.



6C Sajikdan Altar of Nobyen-dong

407-4 Nobyen-dong, Suseong-gu
Constructed during the early Joseon Dynasty, it served as an altar where the local governor conducted rites to honor the god of lands (sa) and the god of grains (jik) on Sajikdan Altar, offering prayers for the nation's peace and a prosperous harvest. Annually, in conjunction with the inauguration date of the Suseong-gu Office, Suseong Sajikje (rite to gods of lands and grains) takes place at this site.



Uksueon Stream is where dinosaur footprints from the Cretaceous period that lasted from about 145 to 66 million years ago in the third and final period of the Mesozoic Era. When this area had been the banks of a lake, two herbivorous dinosaurs walked here and left behind 15 rows of footprints in two different strata.

5C Daegu Samsung Lions Park

1 Yagyeonseol-ro, Suseong-gu 053-780-3300
Daegu Samsung Lions Park is Korea's first octagonal-shaped baseball park, inspired by a baseball diamond. The Park is known for its beautiful design as well as its convenience, with the bleachers close to the ground and more than 80% of the seats in the stands. There are also seats specially designed for events.



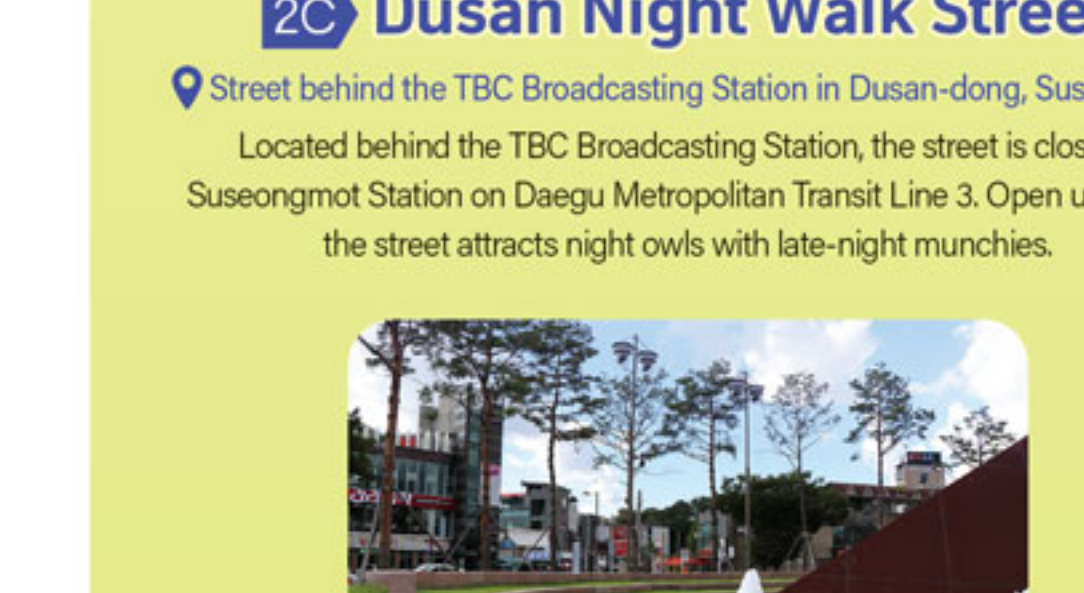
5A Suseong Family Park

88-46 Palhyeon-gil, Suseong-gu
Suseong Family Park is equipped with various amusement and sport facilities, including a pool for children, an inline skating rink, a mini soccer field, a badminton court, and a golf rink. The outdoor pool is open for twenty minutes per hour, starting from noon to 5 o'clock in the afternoon only during the summers from July until September.



2B Beomeo Sikjigamu Experts Alley

The street behind the Grand Hotel in Beomeo-dong, Suseong-gu
Rich with a culinary history, the Beomeo Food Town is famous for a wide range of international cuisines including a 40-year-old Mandu store.



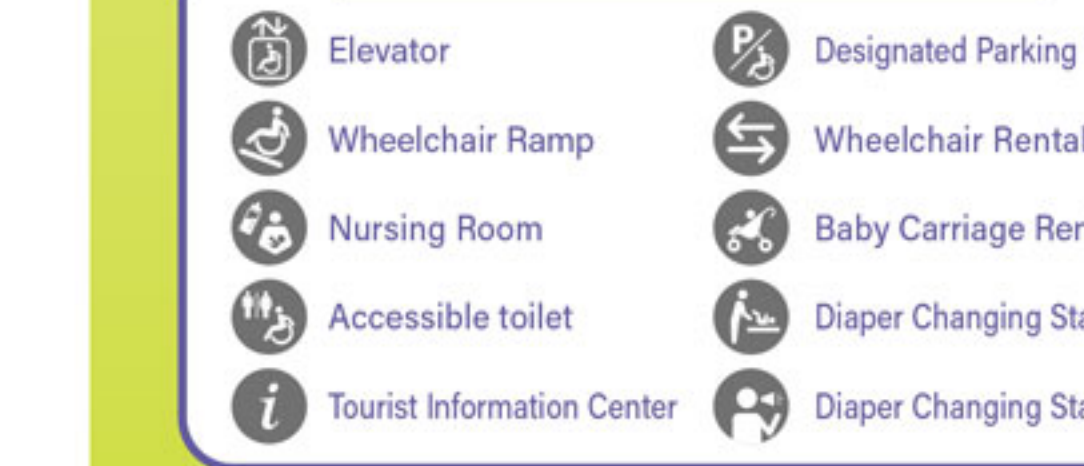
2C Dusan Night Walk Street

Street behind the TBC Broadcasting Station in Dusan-dong, Suseong-gu
Located behind the TBC Broadcasting Station, the street is close to Suseongmot Station on Daegu Metropolitan Transit Line 3. Open until late, the street attracts night owl with late-night munchies.



2C Suseongmot Food Town

Area surrounding Uluru Culture Plaza in Dusan-dong, Suseong-gu
Located to the east of Suseongmot Pond, this food town includes over 180 restaurants and diners specializing in a wide range of cuisines.



Area surrounding Sinmae Plaza in Sinmae-dong, Suseong-gu
Conveniently situated near Sinmae Station on the Metropolitan Transit Line 2, this food alley is especially popular among young people in their 20s and 30s. There are trendy franchise coffee shops, family restaurants, and restaurants serving exotic foreign cuisines.
